Tournament luncheons will have set menus and reservations will be necessary. Sign-up sheets will be posted in the ladies' locker room. On all other meeting days, lunch may be ordered from the menu.

Tournament Formats & Scoring

Alternate Shot—Two-person teams alternate hitting the same ball. The first player tees off, the second player hits the second shot, the first player hits the third shot and so on until the ball is holed out. Tee balls are alternated so that the same player does not hit every tee shot. One team score is recorded using a percentage of each member's handicap (the Pro will calculate the handicap).

Best Ball of Group—2, 3 or 4 member teams are formed. Each player plays her own ball. Use net best ball of player using handicap as it falls on the holes for each team. The best ball of each team is used for the team score. Keep your gross scores for the handicap computer.

Choose 'em & Lose 'em—This is a scramble format except that for each shot, the person whose shot was selected does not hit the following shot.

Eraser - Erase four holes from your score. You must commit to erasing a hole BEFORE you play the next hole. Hole #18 (or your final hole) cannot be erased.

Fairways & Putts- Each tee shot that lands on the fairway = 5 points; Each tee shot that lands on par 3 green = 5 points. Then, deduct number of putts. Yes, score can be negative. Winners based on most points. Winners: 3 places per flight

Hate 'Em—BEFORE PLAY, each player circles 1 par 3, 1 par 4 and 1 par 5 and reduces them to par.

Las Vegas Scramble - A variation of a regular Scramble using a 6-sided die. Before play begins each team member is assigned a number from 1-4. Each player tees off and then the die is thrown. If the number is 1, 2, 3 or 4, the drive of the team member whose number matches must be used. If the number comes up 5 or 6, the team can choose the best drive. The hole is then played out as a normal scramble.

NOTE: Each player must tee off before the die is rolled. One team score is recorded using a percentage of each member's handicap (the Pro will calculate the handicap). When possible, the teams will be formed with A, B, C & D players.

Lighten the Load—Each player selects any four (4) clubs and must play the entire round using only those 4 selected clubs.

Low Gross/Low Net—Record total strokes for gross score and deduct handicap for net score.

Low Putts—Only putts are counted for the tournament, keep your gross score for the handicap computer. NOTE: If player is on the green and putts off the green, the strokes used to return to the green are not counted, but all strokes while on the green are counted.

Morale Builder — Gross score of best 12 holes.

Mutt AND Jeff—Keep gross score for handicap computer. Total gross and net score for the par-3 and par-5 holes are computed for score.

Mutt OR Jeff—Play round as usual. At the end of the round, a draw will be held to eliminate either the 5 longest holes or the 5 shortest holes. Winners: 1 low gross & 2 low nets per flight

Nassau—Keep gross score for the computer and a net score for the game of the day. Prizes will be awarded on the best net scores from front nine, back nine and the total 18. For 9-holers, use first 4, last 5, total 9. There will be one payout per person.

Nobody Knows—2-person best ball with a blind draw for your partner after the round.

Scramble - Each golfer hits her drive. The best drive is selected, and all players hit their second shots from there and so on until the ball is holed out. One team score is recorded using a percentage of each member's handicap (calculated by Pro). When possible, the teams are formed with A, B, C & D players.

Stableford—Players are awarded points based on net scores of each hole—highest point total wins: Double Bogies or More = 0 Pt.; Bogie = 1 Pt.; Par = 2 Pts; Birdie = 3 Pts. Eagle = 4 Pts; Double Eagle = 5 Pts.

Tee to Green - strokes to reach the green are counted (keep your gross score for the handicap computer). NOTE: If ball lands on green, then rolls off, the strokes to return to the green are counted.

3 Blind Mice—Net score minus 3 holes drawn by the Pros after play.

3 Little Pigs—Throw out 3 worst holes following play and report net score on remaining 15 holes.

Thursday Play Days

Tee Times On regular Thursday Play Days, tee times will be 9:30 in April and October, 9:00 May and September, and 8:30 June, July and August. For major tournaments we will have shotgun starts, unless otherwise required by restrictions.

Pro Shop Responsibilities The Pro Shop will form the groups, and will determine the hole assignments for the shotgun starts. The Pro Shop will create a “lag” between the last WGA group to play through #1.

WGA Member Responsibilities Let the Pro Shop know by Wednesday if she will play on Thursday. Each member will call to cancel if she cannot play on Thursday. Each member will arrive on time. All members will honor golf's Pace of Play rules

BY-LAWS OF THE SFCC WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this organization shall be the Santa Fe Country Club Women's Golf Association.

ARTICLE II - OBJECT

The object of this Association shall be to support and promote the best interest of the Santa Fe Country Club and to foster the true spirit of the game of golf. The Association shall organize and conduct a program of golf and social activities.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Article III – Membership. Membership shall be open to all women who live in the vicinity of Santa Fe, with exception for junior golfers. There shall be three classes of membership: Golf, Junior Golf and Social. Women who are not members of the Santa Fe Country Club that join the Association may access the Country Club on Association sponsored event days and may purchase food and drink by credit card and those playing golf must pay green fees.

A special category of membership has been established for junior women golfers who come with the recommendation of one of the SFCC professionals. The junior woman must be the daughter of a member in good standing with the SFCC. The junior woman golfer should be a full time student. She would be eligible to play in all Thursday play and all summer tournaments. Membership would be from June 1- August 31.

ARTICLE IV - GOVERNEMENT

The Association shall be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of elected officers and standing committee chairmen.

- A. The Board shall meet previous to the regular monthly meeting of the Association.
- B. Vacancies in all offices and committee chairmanships, except that of the President, shall be filled by appointment of the President with the approval of the Board.
- C. The Social Committee, consisting of a chairman and at least two other members, shall make arrangements for monthly membership luncheon meetings and other social activities as directed by the Board.

ARTICLE VII – MEMBERSHIP DUES

Annual dues for golf, junior golf and social members, as established by vote of the membership, shall be paid directly to the Treasurer. Dues are payable on January 1 and must be paid by the date a Ways and Means Committee is established, the chairman of that committee shall also serve on the Budget Committee. At the beginning of the year, the committee shall plan a balanced budget for the Association for the approval of the Board. Throughout the year, the committee shall assist the Board in maintaining budget as formulated, and make appropriate revisions as necessary.

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS, THEIR DUTIES, AND THEIR ELECTION

- A. Officers – The Officers of the Association shall be President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.
- B. Duties of Officers
 1. **President:** shall preside at all meetings of the Association and the Board; shall appoint, with the approval of the Board, all standing committee chairmen and special committees deemed necessary by the Board; shall be ex-officio member of all committees except the nominating committee; shall serve as a regular member of the SFCC Board of Directors and represent the Association during her term of office.
 2. **Vice-President:** shall act as assistant to President; In the absence of the President, shall preside at all meetings and shall assume the office of President in case of vacancy; shall serve as Membership chairman, Handbook chairman, and make arrangements for the Annual Membership Coffee.
 3. **Secretary:** shall keep all records of membership and Board meetings of the Association and conduct correspondence as directed by the President.
 4. **Treasurer:** shall collect and receive all monies due the Association and shall disburse funds under the direction of the Board; shall report receipts, expenditures and balances at Association meetings; shall maintain and submit books for audit at the close of the fiscal year, December 31st.
- C. Election of Officers

The membership shall elect a nominating committee at the August meeting consisting of five members. The nominating committee shall present a slate of candidates for office at the September meeting. Election of Officers shall be held at the October meeting, at which time nominations may be made from the floor with the consent of the nominee. Election shall be by whatever mode of balloting the Board selects. The nominee with a plurality of votes shall be declared elected. Elected officers shall assume their duties after the November meeting.

ARTICLE VI - STANDING COMMITTEES

Committees of the Association shall consist of, but not be limited to the following, and may vary at the discretion of the Board:

A. The Tournament Chairman shall be appointed by elected officers. She shall form a committee of at least four members. At the beginning of the year, this committee, in consultation with the Country Club Pro and Manager, shall prepare a schedule of weekly

B. The Budget Chairman shall head a committee comprised of the Treasurer, Tournament Chairman and a representative from the Nine-Hole golf members. In those years when

ARTICLE VII – MEMBERSHIP DUES

Annual dues for golf, junior golf and social members, as established by vote of the membership, shall be paid directly to the Treasurer. Dues are payable on January 1 and must be paid by the date of the membership Coffee to assure listing in the Handbook. The Handbook shall include members in good standing as determined from the Treasurer's records. New or returning members who join before August 1 shall pay established dues; those who join after August 1 shall pay one-half of the established golf or social member dues. Junior membership dues are to be one-half of the regular golf membership.

ARTICLE VIII – MEETINGS

Monthly business meetings shall be held on the third Thursday of each month unless otherwise designated by the Board. Organized golf events shall be planned by the Tournament Committee for each Thursday morning throughout the season.

ARTICLE IX – RULES OF ORDER

The rules contained in Robert's Rules of Order Revised shall govern the Association in all cases where they are applicable and are not in conflict with the By-Laws.

ARTICLE X – AMENDMENTS

These By-Laws may be amended, revised, or repealed, or new By-laws may be adopted, after being presented and considered during at least two Association meetings, by affirmative vote of the majority of the members present at a meeting of the Association.

ARTICLE XI – STANDING RULES

Standing rules for the operation of the club may be adopted by a majority vote of the membership present so long as they are consistent with and not contrary to the By-Laws herein.

STANDING RULES FOR 2021

1. Junior members of the WGA must be qualified by the club professional to play 18 holes within a 40.4 index, and will play with the 18-hole players on WGA days.
2. New WGA members shall be eligible to play with 18-hole players with an established index. If a new member does not have an established handicap, she shall be qualified to play with either the 18-hole or the 9-hole players by the club professional and shall establish a handicap by turning in scorecards from 10 rounds of play.
3. Members intending to play Thursday golf shall sign up by Wednesday afternoon in order to be flighted for Thursday play. **ALL** members are welcome to play on Thursday, but they may be randomly placed and/or not flighted if they cannot comply with the Wednesday requirement.
4. Major Tournaments – Scores are not to be posted in the computer. Scorecards shall be turned into the handicap or tournament chairman, who will post these scores under a special category.
5. Major Tournaments – Ties for the winner of the trophy will be decided by a playoff beginning at the first hole and continuing until a winner is determined.
6. The Hole-In-One pot can be won on any official WGA play day.
7. To be considered for the Most Improved Player Award a member must have played a minimum of 7 official WGA Play Days.
8. On any official WGA play day the ball is to be played down (no rolling). Any exceptions will be set by the Club Pro.
